



EGGS-CITING RACE

Ages 4+ | Family based | 2+ players | Easter Theme

AIM OF THE GAME



- ▶ Run from your basket and take as many socks ('egg'/'eggs') as possible, however you can only take one egg at a time. The winner is the person with the most eggs in their basket / bowl.

EQUIPMENT



- ▶ Socks (make them ball shaped)
- ▶ Bowl / Basket

HOW TO PLAY



- ▶ Set up a pile of socks in the middle of the area, rolled like a ball to be used as eggs.
- ▶ Each child has one basket or bowl each and moves equal steps away from the pile of eggs.
- ▶ They stand next to their baskets and on the word 'GO' run into the middle and pick one egg (sock) and take back to their basket.
- ▶ Repeat this until all the eggs have been picked.
- ▶ The winner is the child with the most eggs in their basket.

GAME VARIATIONS



1. Try different Easter themed movements to the basket. What is your best impression of a bunny hops with the egg?
2. Collect the eggs using another body part other than your hands.
3. Roll or throw the eggs back to the basket from the centre.
4. Hide eggs around the house or garden and once all the eggs have gone from the middle, children can go and find the special eggs hidden around the house or garden.
