Meet the Mascot: Hop to the Top

GOAL SETTING

Girl Scouts create a jumping lop-eared rabbit mascot using paper cups. When the cup flies, the lop ears flop—bringing the mascot to life.

Explore More Possibilities by challenging Girl Scouts to see how high their rabbit can hop. Connect the activity to goal setting by asking Girl Scouts to write their goal on the base of the cup as a reminder.

Hop to the Top Template

Cut out the rabbit face and paste to your upside down cup. Cut out ears and glue to the bottom of the cup. Punch a hole on each side of the rim of the cup. Tie and knot a rubber band through each hole. Push the rabbit cup on top of an upside down plain cup until you feel tension. Release to see how high the rabbit can jump.
